



Important Dorm Information:

- Each group of up to **35** students is assigned to one floor of a dormitory.
- If you have a small group you may share a building with another school group, but you will have one floor privately assigned to your group.
- Rooms have 2 twin beds each. **Linens are not provided.**
- **Key FOBs** to access dormitories are for adults only. Please only use the east facing door and do not prop entry doors open.
- Please use the keys to unlock only the rooms assigned and please do not use more rooms than you need.
- Keep rooms unlocked during your visit. For valuables and medicines, choose one room (a teacher's or chaperone's) and keep them locked in there.
- Please **keep the ACs on** and shut room doors when not in use. This will keep the moisture down in the rooms. (Does not apply in winter.)
- Housekeeping comes through daily for routine cleaning but please help keep the dorms tidy. They check to see if the AC is on in the rooms.
- Each floor has access to a broom closet with basic cleaning supplies.
- Please do not wear **wet shoes** into the dorms. There are "shoe trees" located outside each dorm for hanging wet shoes.
- Do not use bug spray or spray sunscreen inside.
- **Check out is at 8:00 AM on your last day.** This gives Housekeeping time to clean and get ready for the next group.
- After check-out, store belongings in the **downstairs lounge** or the **storage building** between dorms. Keys are available upon request.
