

Your Computer and Internet Access

A computer lab with 12 desktop PC's and a laser printer/copier is located in the Administration building in the library. These computers are networked and have high-speed access to the Internet. The computer lab and library are opened during summer terms as follows: Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. - 10:30 p.m. Saturday, 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. Sunday, 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. - 10:30 p.m. Library times for the rest of the year depend on your GRS status. Please see someone in IT or your advisor.

STUDENTS WILL HAVE ACCESS TO THE LIBRARY/COMPUTER LAB DURING THESE HOURS ONLY. Computer support staff will be available Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Dorm Room Access

In addition to the computer lab, the Dauphin Island Sea Lab has provided its resident college students, who have their own computers, access to a high-speed connection to the Internet in their dorm rooms and graduate student offices. Connection to this network is done at the students' own risk, and the Dauphin Island Sea Lab is not responsible for material viewed or downloaded by users from the Internet, or damage to computers on this network.

Equipment needed for connection to the dorm network includes a 10/100 Base-T Network Interface Card (NIC), and a Category 5 patch cable (10 feet should be sufficient). A modem will not work with the dorm high-speed network. A battery backup or uninterruptible power supply (UPS) is recommended, as the power on campus tends to fluctuate.

Purchase and installation of the NIC is completely the responsibility of the student. The Dauphin Island Sea Lab does not have the resources to install the cards in individual students' computers or configure each system to connect to the Internet. Check your owner's manual before purchasing an NIC and configuring your network connection. You can request an instruction sheet from the computer support staff for your operating system to assist you in connecting to the Internet.

It is very important that you have an antivirus program before you put your computer on the DISL network. Please see computer support if you need assistance acquiring antivirus software. *It is also just as important that you keep this antivirus up to date with weekly definition updates!*

Internet Access Policy
